# HONORARY LIFE MEMBER AWARD POLICY

## Purpose and scope

This policy applies to all BUA Members.

## Policy

A member who is nominated for Honorary Life Membership can be a member of the Association past or present who has gone above and beyond for the Association, but may not have umpired.

This Award opens up for future Honorary Life Members from NCFLUG, NDFUA, LVUG or any other Association that we join with and acknowledging their Life Members. Members from the BUA who have left the Association due to AFL/VFL commitments, but still represented the BUA, may not have made the 20 years criteria.

Voting Members of the meeting shall take into account the performance of the member and that the service given to the Association was above and beyond the call of duty, which entails considerable effort and personal time without recompense and beyond the course of normal activities for the benefit of the Association.

## Procedure for Honorary Life Membership Voting

1. A special Gathering (meeting) shall be convened and chaired by the General Manager. Other than the General Manager there shall be seven (7) members of the gathering (meeting) present. This shall consist of as many Board members that are available at the time of the gathering (meeting), excluding any Board member that may be nominated for a Life Membership. The balance is to be made up of current running Life Members of the Association.
2. The person nominating a member for Honorary Life Membership is to be present to state their case why the nominee should be considered for Honorary Life Membership.
3. Voting is to be conducted by way of secret ballot. A nominee who receives 80% or more of the ballot in the affirmative shall be awarded a Honorary Life Membership.
